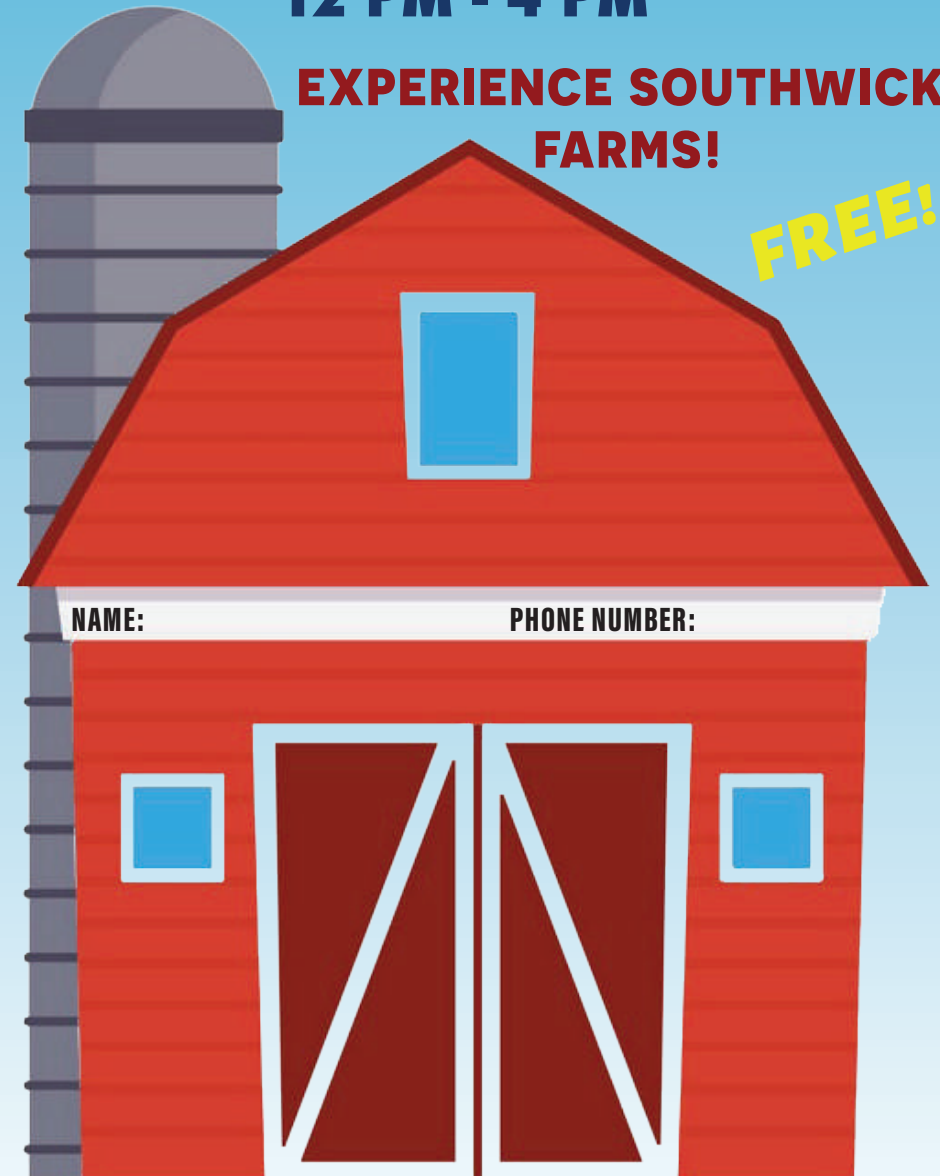

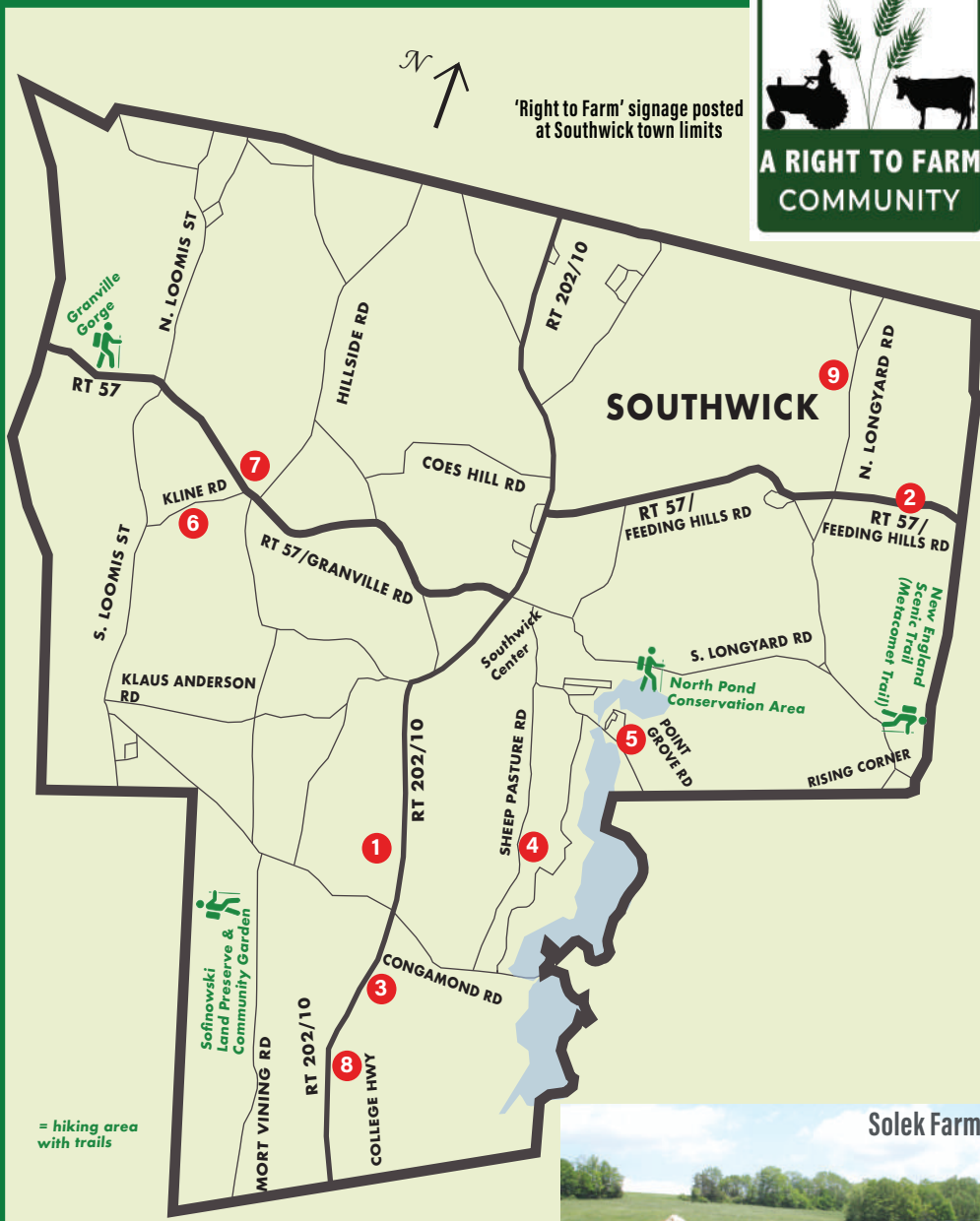
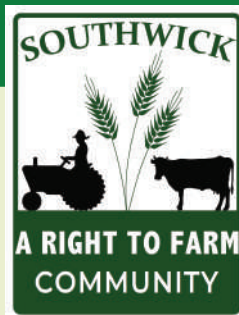

- 1. Blossoming Acres**
249 College Highway
Vegetables, fruits, annual & perennial plants, cut flowers, in-store baked goods, local meats & dairy, crafts. Offering wagon rides and tours of fields!
- 2. Calabrese Farm**
257 Feeding Hills Road
Vegetables, fruits, annual & perennial plants, local honey and bread. Visit the farm and read about its history!
- 3. Coward Farm**
150 College Highway
Visit the greenhouses and see where plants are grown! Also, Christmas trees are grown in the fields here. Annual & perennial plants, trees and shrubs, pumpkins, Christmas trees and greens, rustic farm furniture in barn.
- 4. Dwight Arnold Tobacco Farm & Sheep Pasture Sunflower Stand**
73 Sheep Pasture Road
Check out an operating tobacco farm and get an inside look into a historic tobacco barn! Also, come see where sunflowers are grown onsite!
- 5. Firefly Fields Farm**
9 Babb Road
Meet friendly livestock that love to be petted and check out homemade goat milk soap, eggs, seasonal produce. Yoga with goats, farm animal parties available!
- 6. Kline View Stables**
53 Kline Road
Meet some horses! A horse stable offering training, boarding, trucking and lessons for beginners and advanced riders.
- 7. Solek Farm**
230 Granville Road
Meet some cows and tractors! Producing hay and natural-raised beef, firewood, straw, and manure. 413Bee apiary onsite with honey tasting and bee hive display.
- 8. Southwick Historical Society**
86 College Highway
Visit the Charles Gillett Cigar Factory onsite to see historical farm artifacts from Southwick farms of the past.
- 9. Bisi Farm**
146 North Longyard Road
Take self-guided tour of this former dairy farm, now hay fields, with views of Provin Mountain.
